Students cultivate their logical thinking skills which enable them to accurately grasp problems facing people and the community and to discover a new welfare while nurturing human relationships. Students also learn methodologies to attain these skills, thereby equipping themselves with skills to realize "one's unique way of life.".

Students also equip themselves with presentation skills so they can contribute as members of medical teams.
